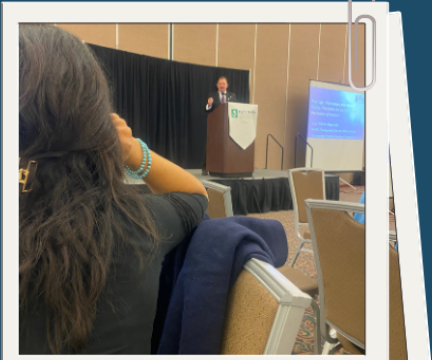

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

On Wednesday, March 18th, our office staff was able to attend Legislative Day put on by Right to Life Michigan in Lansing. We came away with a wealth of knowledge and inspiration to take action in our upcoming election cycle! The Honorable William Wagner (Ret.) was the keynote speaker. Professor Wagner represented Right to Life of Michigan in *Dobbs v. Jackson*, the case that overturned *Roe v. Wade*. His talk focused on strengthening family in order to create a culture of life where family plays the most important role, not the schools or bureaucrats.

We are currently watching 9 pro-life bills and resolutions at the State level, and 5 that are anti-life. Of particular interest right now are HB 5201, 5202, and 5203 regarding Abortion Reporting and Abortion Complication Reporting, which is no longer required. Women have a right to know accurate information about the procedure they are considering undergoing or medicine they are considering taking. These bills would restore laws Michigan had for over four decades. Please contact your legislators and ask them to support or oppose the following:

- HR 195: Resolution Opposing Health Education Standards
- HB 4055: State Child Tax Credit

- HB 4058 & 4059: Tax-Free Baby Items

ANTI-LIFE BILLS TO OPPOSE

- HB 4133 & 4134 / SB 154 & 155: State FACE Act
- SB 359: Data Privacy Act

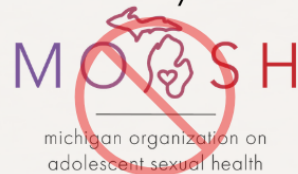

BE AWARE

One of the most dangerous organizations you have never heard of...

MOASH stands for the Michigan Organization on Adolescent Sexual Health. Their stated mission is to "mobilize youth voices, engage community partners, and inform decision-makers to advance sexual health, identities, and rights". They advocate for radical access to abortion for minors without parental consent. Since coming out against the Parental Consent law, MOASH has begun a website toolkit directing minors on how to acquire a judicial bypass to circumvent the parental consent law altogether. MOASH has also become an integrated component of school districts across the state and is now the sole training organization for all Teen Outreach Program facilitators due to an exclusive state contract. Additionally, they run paid Youth Advisory Councils where students are trained on how to become advocates for sex-ed reform, civil rights, and "reproductive rights", both in school and to elected officials. MOASH is mainly funded through federal and state funds to administer pregnancy prevention programming among other initiatives, but also receives "pass-through" dollars from MDHHS as well as private donations and grants - including George Soros's Open Society Foundation.
